ORDINANCE NO. 12092024- C

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TOWN OF LYMAN, SOUTH CAROLINA, CODE OF ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE I, SECTIONS 16-24 AND 16-30, AMENDING LANGUAGE REGARDING REMOVAL OF LIMBS, CUTTINGS AND OTHER DEBRIS BY THE TOWN

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that it is in the interest of the Town, for the benefit of the health, order, safety, general welfare and convenience of the Town and its residents, to amend the Town of Lyman, South Carolina, Code of Ordinances, as follows:

- 1. CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE I, SECTION 16-24, SUBSECTION B currently reads as follows:**

Sec. 16-24. - Green waste regulations.

“(b) Collection. The town will remove normal seasonal quantities of green wastes from residential locations. A contractor performing landscaping or tree removal shall be responsible for removing and disposing of green waste resulting from its operations. Abnormal quantities of green wastes resulting from owner operations may be collected by the town, if feasible, after normal collection is completed. A fee for collection of abnormal quantities of green waste shall be collected in advance as set by the administrator based on costs of personnel, equipment and landfill fees. Whole trees, stumps and land clearing debris will not be collected by the town, but shall be removed from the location and disposed of properly by the property owner or contractor performing removal.”

**CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE I, SECTION 16-24, SUBSECTION B SHALL BE AMENDED TO REMOVE THE FOLLOWING PORTION OF SENTENCE #2:
“A contractor performing landscaping” Subsection B will now read as follows:**

“The town will remove normal seasonal quantities of green wastes from residential locations. A contractor performing tree removal shall be responsible for removing and disposing of waste associated with the tree removal operations. Abnormal quantities of green waste resulting from owner operations may be collected by the town, if feasible, after normal collection is completed. A fee for collection of abnormal quantities of green waste shall be collected in advance as set by the administrator based on costs of personnel, equipment and landfill fees. Whole trees, stumps and land clearing debris will not be collected by the town, but shall be removed from the location and disposed of properly by the property owner or contractor performing removal.

2. CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE I, SECTION 16-30 CURRENTLY READS AS FOLLOWS:

“Sec. 16-30. - Removal of limbs, cuttings and other debris.

No limbs, trees, cuttings or other debris will be removed by town forces as a result of work done by any contractor. All building materials and other refuse, whether the work be done by the hour or the contract price shall be removed by the contractor responsible for the work.”

CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE I, SECTION 16-30 SHALL BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

“Removal of grass clippings, leaves, brush and other yard waste debris

Green waste will be collected by the town from residential homes; green waste is strictly limited to residential yard clippings from routine pruning and landscaping activities. It does NOT include debris generated from commercial tree cutting or land clearing.

Grass clippings from routine yard cutting will be collected by the Town. Place clippings separately at the edge of property clear of any mailboxes or other structures preventing pick-up.


Leaves from routine yard clean-up will be collected by the Town. Leaf piles must be separated from all other debris and placed separately at the edge of property clear of any mailboxes or other structures preventing pick-up”

Brush from routine yard clean-up will be picked up by the Town this includes twigs and small sticks and limbs. These must be placed separately from other yard debris at the edge of property clear of any mailboxes or other structures preventing pick-up”

“The Town will not pay for or reimburse any contractor who removes any of the above debris”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS OF THE TOWN OF LYMAN IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED, that the amendments as indicated in the above revised sections are hereby approved.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon second reading approval by the Town Council.
