



**Town of Lyman, South Carolina
Street Maintenance Technician
Public Works Department**

The Town of Lyman is accepting applications for the position of Street Maintenance Technician within the Public Works Department.

This position performs a variety of skilled, semi-skilled, and manual labor tasks related to the maintenance, repair, and improvement of the Town's streets, rights-of-way, storm drainage systems, and other public infrastructure. The position reports to the Street Maintenance Supervisor and works under the overall direction of the Public Works Director.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Perform maintenance and repair of Town streets, shoulders, rights-of-way, and drainage systems.
- Operate a variety of equipment, including leaf collection equipment, dump trucks, tractors, mowers, chainsaws, and other Public Works vehicles and equipment.
- Assist with storm debris removal, roadside maintenance, vegetation management, and emergency response operations.
- Install, repair, and maintain traffic signs, culverts, drainage structures, and other public infrastructure.
- Perform manual labor involving lifting, digging, shoveling, raking, and equipment operation.
- Assist with special projects, community events, and other Public Works operations as assigned.
- Perform routine equipment inspections and basic preventative maintenance.
- Work cooperatively with other Town departments to provide quality public services.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Street Maintenance Supervisor, Public Works Director, or their designee.

Minimum Qualifications

- High school diploma or GED preferred.
- Valid South Carolina driver's license required.
- South Carolina Class B Commercial Driver's License (CDL) required.
- Ability to safely operate trucks, equipment, and power tools.
- Ability to understand and follow written and verbal instructions.

- Ability to work effectively in a team-oriented environment.
- Ability to perform physically demanding work in varying weather conditions.

Working Conditions

This position requires frequent standing, walking, bending, lifting, climbing, and manual labor. Employees regularly work outdoors in hot, cold, wet, and humid conditions and may be exposed to moving traffic, heavy equipment, noise, dust, insects, and other hazards associated with street maintenance and construction activities.

This position may require occasional overtime, evening work, weekend work, or emergency call-out during severe weather or other emergency events.

Employment Requirements

- Pre-employment drug screening required.
- Background check required.
- Must maintain a valid driver's license and any required certifications throughout employment.
